On behalf of the Organizing Committee, it is my great pleasure to introduce the highlight event, "Live surgery from Korea", to all of you.

Recently, the East Asian Society of Endourology (EASE) was established, and the correlation of endourologists between Korea and Japan has been getting closer than before. In addition, the year 2002 was a historical year for both Korea and Japan because the World Cup Soccer Tournament was successfully co-hosted by two countries for the first time in history. This was when the broadband Internet via the Korea-Japan submarine optical cable was also established. Using the big broadband network, our medical team (Chief: Dr. Shuji Shimizu, Department of Endoscopic Diagnosis and Therapeutics, Kyushu University, Japan) started the Korea-Japan Telemedical Network Project (included in Hyeonhae/Genkai Project) in 2003. In contrast to conventional telecommunications using the narrow band, high quality motion images do not deteriorate during transmission and exactly the same quality of pictures can be seen at the receiving end of the network. Up to now, several live surgeries and teleconferences have been successfully performed in the field of general surgery between the two countries.

At this annual meeting, we have specifically planned to have live surgery performed using the big broadband network from Korea for the first time in the urological field. Hanyang University in Seoul is also a member of the Korea-Japan Telemedical Network Project, and Prof. Tchun Young Lee (Department of Urology, Hanyang University, Korea) kindly approved our request to perform live surgery. In addition, this live surgery will also be broadcasted to the auditorium hall in Hanyang University, where active members of the Korean Endourological Society will also participate as a joint meeting. Excitingly, it is our good fortune that Prof. Inderbir S. Gill (Cleveland Clinic Foundation, USA), one of the most active laparoscopic urologic surgeons in the world, has kindly accepted our request to be the operator in the live surgery. We are planning a laparoscopic partial nephrectomy, one of the most technically challenging laparoscopic operations, for this live surgery demonstration. I believe that this exciting event will promote our professional relationship and good friendship with the urologists of Korea and USA. We hope that all participants will be satisfied with this live surgery demonstration and that this event will foster many fruitful discussions between Korea and Japan.

Especially, in this year, it will be held jointly with KR-JP APII 10Gbps Launching Ceremony to celebrate the upgraded to 10Gbps of the APII Testbed between Korea and Japan on December 2006.

During last 3 years, APII Workshop has played a leading role lively to make information exchanges and relevant applications on APII Testbeds in this region, mostly initiated by Korea and Japan, working for mutual lasting development. As a result, it has brought out the necessity for deploying international Advanced Networks in Asia-Pacific and the importance of relevant policies. And it has also contributed to make an environment for collaborative joint research by using advanced technology and education. With these efforts, the APII Testbed between Korea and Japan has been successfully upgraded to 10Gbps. Now, APII Workshop is expanding its boundary of participation including Southeast Asia, North America and Europe to connect with other international Advanced Networks like TEIN2, TransPAC2 and etc.

The APII Workshop 2007, which celebrates KR-JP 10Gbps Launch, will be a good opportunity to discuss development and collaboration on international Advanced Networks with following two sessions: "Future Internet" and "10G applications in APII", and also to verify its developments both in qualitative and quantitative aspects by showing a live tele-surgery demonstration between Korea and Japan by using a bulk of HD data transfer through KR-JP APII Testbed. I wish that this Workshop will be a good opportunity to share experience and opportunity to every country which gives all attention and makes efforts in international Advanced Networks, and to discuss global cooperation for mutual development.
