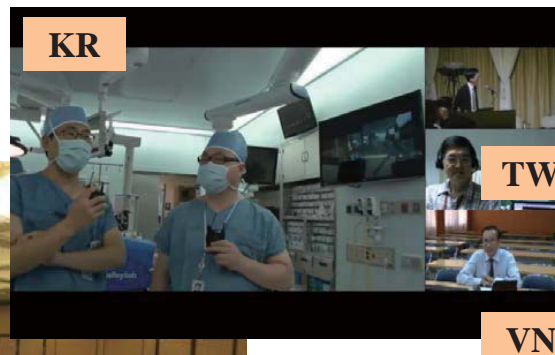
Major achievements 2013.4–2014.3

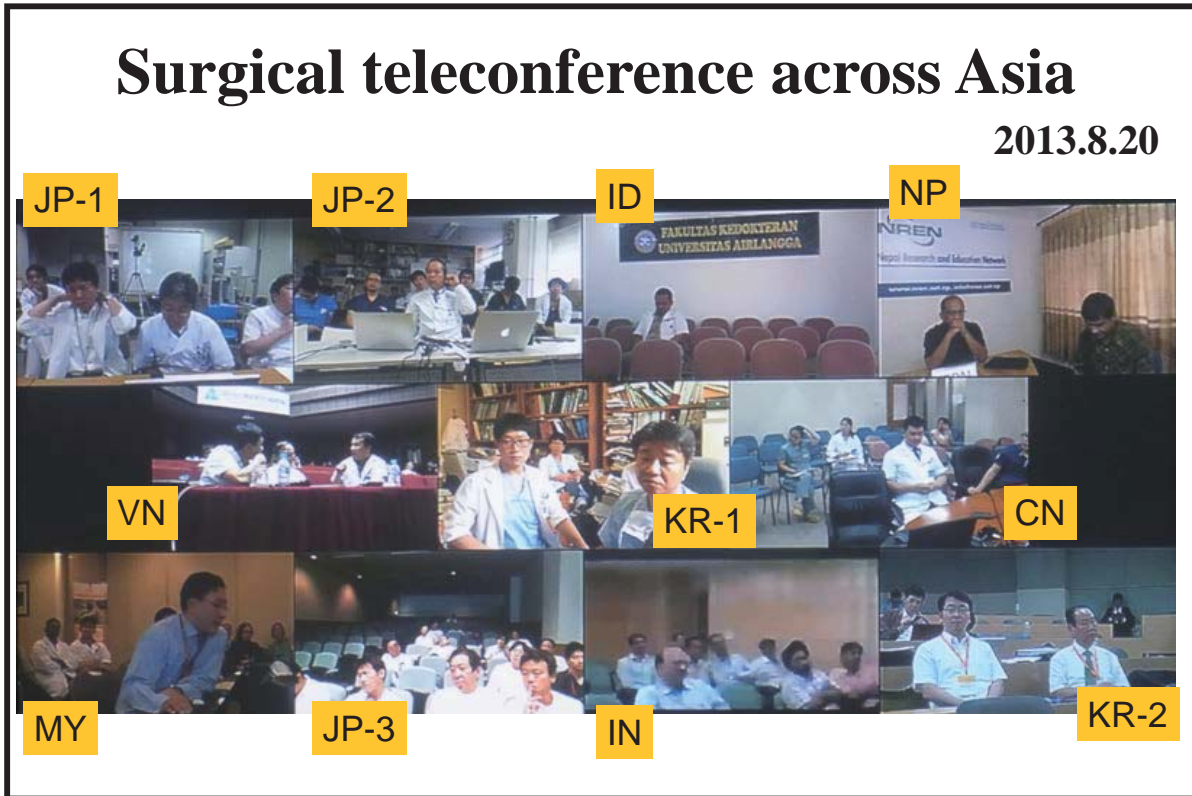

Surgical teleconference was organized with many remote stations in Asia.



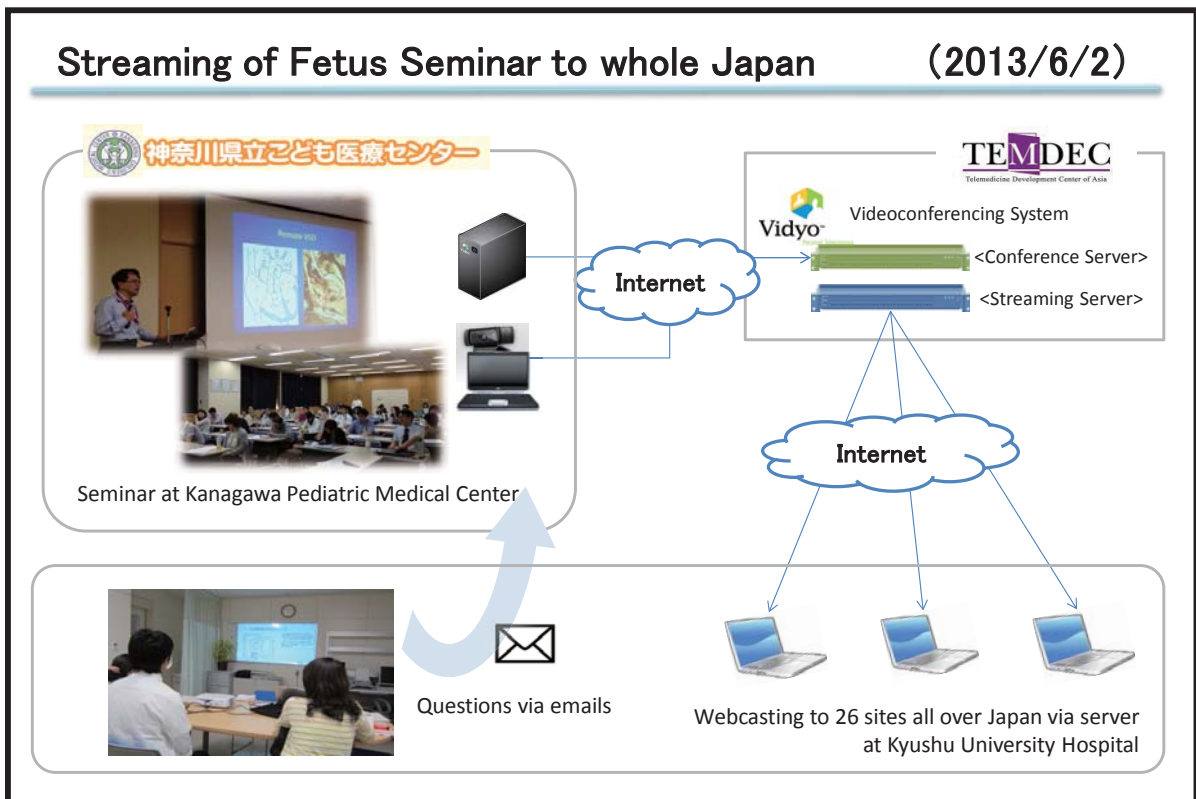
Research and Education Network in Central Asia has started its service, and the active participations will be expected.
