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Abstract: Green buildings or eco-friendly buildings mostly concentrate on the efficient use of energy in house hold electromechanical equipment. In an over populated country like Bangladesh where only 62% of its people are having the privilege of using electricity and which is not sufficient (only 7000-8000MW) for a country like Bangladesh.
