The 11th Asia Telemedicine Symposium: Application of Educational Telemedicine in Teaching Hospitals

The 11th Asia Telemedicine Symposium (ATS2017) was held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, on December 15th and 16th, 2017. During the two-day symposium, 44 presentations were made from 13 countries, including remote speakers. Over 150 people from 12 countries attended at the venue, University of Malaya Medical Centre. The symposium was observed by streaming in 7 other sites. Dr. Ho Shiaw Hooi, chairman of ATS2017, gave the opening remarks in line with this year's theme, "Application of Educational Telemedicine in Teaching Hospitals". He hoped that ideas can be pooled, at the same time, more concerted effort should be made to boost educational activities through the use of telemedicine in teaching hospitals. It is true that telemedicine for educational purpose is getting more recognized, and people are trying to make a profitable use of it. However, some people have limitation in activity due to lack of support, knowledge, equipment or good Internet. ATS could be a solution because both experienced medical doctors and engineers gathered there. They are opening their arms to welcome new members to expand and enrich their activity.

In the Plenary Session on Day 1, presentations on active educational telemedicine in Malaysia, India, the Philippines, Singapore and Indonesia were made. Prof. Kenshi Yao spoke on telemedicine in multi-centre collaborative research. This research involves centres in Asia, such as China, Vietnam, Thailand, Bangladesh, etc. Telemedicine helps international researches, which contribute to world healthcare, to work smoothly despite physical distance.

Day 2 started with reports from emerging institutions. Mr. Poggy Indra Aditya, Indonesia, described in his presentation how relationship between doctors and engineers changed after the 1st Indonesia Telemedicine Workshop in 2016. One of the aims of our activity is to create a good relationship between doctors and engineers. His presentation proved that it is coming along. Concurrent sessions, JSPS seminar and Engineering Workshop, followed. Heated discussions were engaged in both sessions, from both perspectives of medical doctors and engineers.

ATS comes back to Fukuoka, Japan, for the 12th meeting in November of 2018. Prof Shimizu
